

Maths:

This half term we will be concentrating the four operations: multiplication and division, and money.

MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION

- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for 3, 4 and 8
- Multiply and divide mentally
- Multiply and divide using written methods

MONEY

- Investigating problems involving money
- Counting money
- Converting pounds and pence
- Giving change

Literacy:

This half term, we will be looking at the differences between formal and informal language. We will be writing formal and informal letters and investigating the different language used in each.

Spelling and grammar rules will be taught each week that will link to the children's spelling homework. This will be given weekly on a Friday, ready for spelling tests on the following Friday.

Spanish:

We will be following the Wakefield Scheme for our Spanish lessons where the children will build on their Spanish knowledge from last year and learn about the following topics:

- Body
- Animals
- Christmas
- Adjectives
- Family
- Pets
- Hobbies

Homework:

Topic:

Our topic this half term is *Ancient Egypt*, in which we'll cover:

- Who were the Ancient Egyptians?
- What was life like in Ancient Egypt?
- Mummies
- Tutankhamun
- Hieroglyphics
- Egyptian Gods

RE:

In RE this half term, we will be asking ourselves 'What matters most?' We will question if rules really matter, what codes for living non-religious people use, what we can learn about good and bad, and right and wrong through drama, what codes for living Christians try to follow, if peace is more valuable than money and if we can create a code for living that will help the world. Children will be given lots of opportunities for discussion, drama and art work throughout.

Science:

Our topic for this half term will be *Rocks*. Areas covered will include types and classifications of rocks, fossils, famous geologist Mary Anning, soil formation, and soil permeability.

Music:

Mr Ubex will be leading music lessons this year.

Our PE lessons this term will take place on a Tuesday and Thursday. On Tuesday's PE lessons, we will be practising our athletics skills and on Thursday the children will be taking part in Forest School again.
