Year 1 have been looking at different types of bullying and how it makes them feel. They decided bullying was horrible and made their own minion ambassadors to have up in their classroom to remind them of this every day.



### Social Responsibility

Year 6 have been looking at their role in being socially responsible. In their values and perceptions workshop they explored the responsibilities we all have to our community and others around us, as well as the responsibilities of individuals to look after the planet. They discussed the outcome of COP26 and whether individuals could make a change to global warming. As part of anti-bullying week, they also discussed how they can make a small change to those people around them.

### Catching Kindness
